Community Response Grants in 2008

Hays Recreation Commission — \$1,500 to purchase soft-play equipment to develop fine motor skills for children between 6 and 18 months of age

Love In a Big World – \$3,500 to provide a musical character develop program building on courage, kindness and honesty. The program was presented in all the elementary schools in Hays and Washington School in Ellis

Young Readers' Conference — \$3,000 to bring a Hispanic author to the conference and provide scholarships for students at Washington Elementary School in Hays

Ellis County Ministerial Alliance — \$500 to support the community Thanksgiving dinner

Cross Road Pregnancy Care Center — \$2,120 to purchase educational programs in Spanish and purchase additional equipment so more individuals could have access to the material
